

# Tunnel Trap™

- ★ 5 inch diameter, 15 inches long, steel construction
- ★ For mink, muskrat, skunk, pine martin, barn rats, weasel, ringtail, etc.
- ★ Treat Tunnel Trap™ by freeing of any oil (boiling in lye or Saniflush, etc.), then rust and dye; paint; or use a trap dye.
- ★ Caution: Do not dry fire.
- ★ Not all sets legal in all states.
- ★ Replacement parts available through manufacturer.

## Land Trapping

- ★ Make your sets look natural!
- ★ Camouflage Tunnel Trap™ with grass, leaves, ground litter, or smear with mud from set area.
- ★ Be sure jaw has sufficient clearance. Don't overload with top covering.
- ★ Make sure Tunnel Trap™ is firmly bedded.
- ★ Lure and bait can be used, if desired.
- ★ Secure Tunnel Trap™ when necessary. Wire can be attached to stationary part of trap spring or axle. (Picture 3a below)

## Underwater Trapping

- ★ Bend pan up 1/2" to 1" as shown in picture 3b.
- ★ Hook under side of Tunnel Trap™ with long pole. (Picture 3a) Place under water in runway, etc.
- ★ Animal will trip pan while swimming through so it isn't critical if trap is upside down.



## Water Trapping

- ★ It is best to leave 1" of water in bottom of Tunnel Trap™.
- ★ To stake in deep water, or side of bank, etc. use rubber bands (may be obtained from inner tubes) and stakes long enough to accomplish 1" base of water.
- ★ Suspended water set (picture 4) works well for muskrat and mink.
